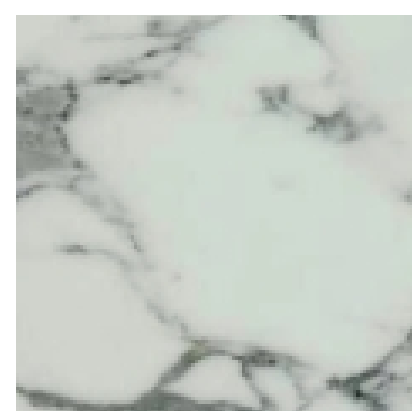
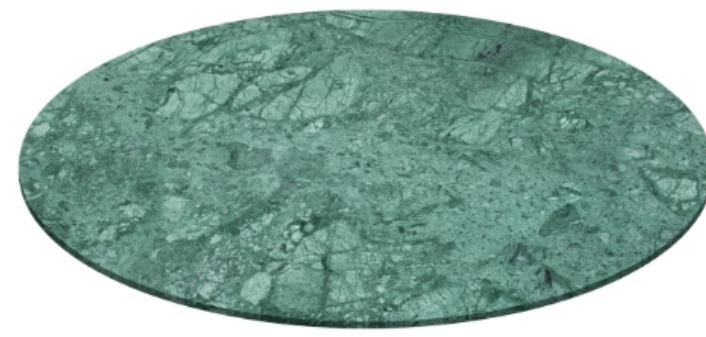


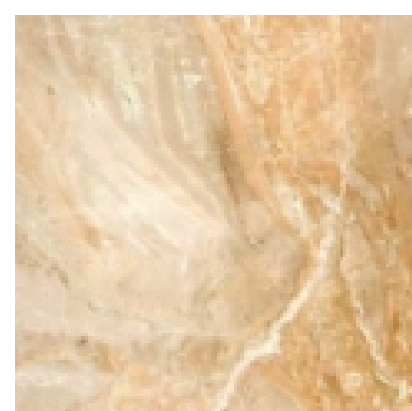

Limestone rock, often veined with varied colors and likely to take a fine polish.

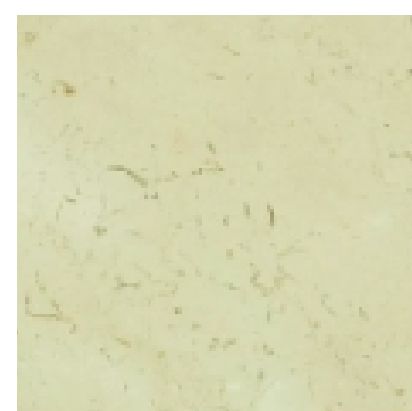
